

Extra Courses on offer:

Executive Committee Training

This training outlines the roles and responsibilities of the Exec Committee and what it means to be a Charity Trustee.

Safeguarding Awareness

This training is delivered by the County Safeguarding Awareness Coordinator, it covers child protection issues and procedures as well as the Anti-bullying policy, and is open to **all adults** involved in Scouting on the Island.

Pioneering Skills Day

This is a one-day course focusing on large-scale pioneering. This day caters for people with varying levels of skills and knowledge related to pioneering, whether you are new to pioneering, or just want to brush up on your skills.

Scouting Skills Evenings/Day

These are evening/one-day courses aimed at teaching adults the core skills that we pass onto the young people in the Sections such as tracking, fire-lighting and backwoods cooking. There is also the opportunity to have a go at some of the adventurous activities that we offer the young people on the one-day course which finishes with a fun team challenge!

Training Clinics

Training Clinics are open access sessions at large County & District events and provide Leaders with an opportunity to meet with a member of the Training Team at an event that they are already attending. Further details on when and where these events are taking place can be found on the website.
