

'Getting Started' in your new role

A New Adult's Guide



Congratulations on your new appointment, and welcome to Scouting on the Isle of Wight. Scouting on the Island is part of a larger national organisation offering challenge and adventure to over 400,000 young people and 100,000 adults across the UK, which in turn is part of a Worldwide Movement with just over 32 million members in 216 different countries!

The Scout Association prides itself on the quality of the Adult Volunteers who take on Leadership and Management roles within the organisation. Part of the reason our Adults are so well prepared and organised is due to the Training that they receive.

The training needs of new adults will vary according to the role that they have volunteered for and their previous experience. 'Getting Started' is the first part of the training that **ALL** adults undertake, and should be completed within 5 months of attending the Appointments Advisory Committee.

Getting Started comprises of the first 3 modules of the Association's Adult Training Scheme:

Module 1 *Essential Information*

This module provides the basic information required for all adults in Scouting; it covers The Fundamentals of Scouting, the Child Protection, Equal Opportunities and Safety Policies of the Association, as well as the support structures in place to help you in your role.

Module 2 *Personal Learning Plan*

This module involves sitting down with a member of the Training Team to create a plan to meet your individual learning needs based on the role you have volunteered for.

Module 3/4 *Tools for the Job*

These modules provide the basic information on the role that you have volunteered for, or your area of responsibility, as well as some practical help to get you started in the role. There are separate modules for those working with the Young People in the Sections (3), and those Managing and Supporting Section Leaders (4).
