

# How to book...

## Online:

You can book online by completing the online booking form found on the Wood Badge Cafe page of the County website at:

When booking online, just make sure that you select the correct reason for your appointment.

You will hear back from the County Training Administrator who will confirm your booking details.

# What's available?

## Face to face meeting with a Training Adviser:

You can book an appointment to meet with a Training Adviser (TA) to complete your Personal Learning Plan (PLP) or validate any training modules that you have completed.

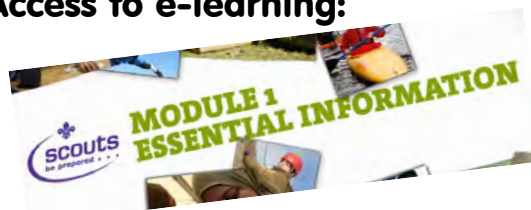


The training team have 2 Skype accounts that you can book a time slot to use so that you can speak to a TA to complete your PLP or validate completed modules. Skype addresses will be given to you on application.

## Booking an Appointment:

You can book an appointment with a TA for either a face to face meeting or using Skype by completing an on-line form on the Wood Badge Cafe page of the website, just select the appropriate choice for the appointment

## Access to e-learning:



You can use the training laptops to access the e-learning modules and DVD's available on the national website.

## Training on 'My Tools'



You can receive training on how to use the Internet resource 'My Tools', which is the online membership database available on the national website.

## Training on Programmes Online

You can receive training on the invaluable scout programming Internet resource 'Programmes Online'. This resource is available to all Leaders in Scouting, and is an excellent place to find lots of programme ideas.



## Training Modules:

Modules from the training scheme are also on offer in a variety of ways:

### One-to-one

Leaders can book to meet with an Adult Trainer to get one-to-one support on a complete module, or part of a module that you would like to know more about.

These sessions can be tailored to suit your needs.

### Small groups

Small groups of leaders wanting the same module can club together and request the module to be delivered at the Wood Badge Cafe.

The training team may also organise this if they are getting the same requests from several people.

### Larger groups

Larger groups of Leaders from the same Section or group can also request normal delivery of specific training modules to take place at the Wood Badge Cafe.
