Section & Assistant Section Leaders



What?

Wood Badge Weekends are a series of weekend training events designed to allow leaders to complete most of the training necessary for their role over the course of 2 weekends. 3 weekends make up the training on offer:

Weekend 1: Core

Weekend 2: Section Leaders

Weekend 3: Managers & Supporters

Section Leaders only need to complete Weekends 1 & 2

When?

Weekend 1: 16th - 18th March

Weekend 2: 14th - 16th September

Where?

1st Newport Scout HQ, The Wendes Hall, Woodbine Close, Newport.

There is parking available at the headquarters.

The full programme including start and finish times and a map of the venue will be provided 2 weeks prior to the event.

Weekend One (Core)

Weekend one covers the core modules common to all adult appointments including:

- 5, Fundamentals
- 6, Changes in Scouting
- 7, Valuing Diversity
- 8, Skills of Leadership
- 9, Working with Adults
- 14, Young People Today
- 19, International

Weekend Two (Section Leaders)

Weekend two covers modules specific to the Section Leader & Assistant Section Leader roles including:

- 11, Administration (Section Leaders)
- 12, Providing a Balanced Programme
- 13, Growing the Section
- 15, Challenging Behaviour
- 16, Introduction to Residential Experiences
- 17, Activities Outdoors
- 18, Practical Skills

Cost?

The weekends are packed full of activities, therefore all of the catering will be provided. Participants have the option of staying at the HQ for the weekend (residential).

The cost of each weekend will be:

Residential £15 per person

Non- Residential £10 per person

These costs cover all meals and refreshments for residential participants, and all meals (excluding breakfast) and refreshments for non-residential participants.

Payment must be made in full 2 weeks prior to the event.

Residential

Participants taking advantage of the residential opportunity will need to bring spare clothing, wash kit and something to sleep in/on.

Plates, mugs, cutlery etc will be provided, and showering facilities are available at the headquarters.
