### Assistant Warden(s)

Many of you will know our Warden Barrie Price – Barrie shoulders much of the burden of the day-to-day running of Corf and at certain times of year – particularly when getting the site ready to open for camping and when occupancy is high in July-August. The Committee are very grateful for all that Barrie does but sometimes he is inevitably overstretched. If you have time available – particularly in the Spring and Summer to assist Barrie then we would be interested in hearing from you. If the right person comes forward then this may evolve into a voluntary Assistant Warden's role or we may involve a number of people on a rota or ad hoc basis.

Primarily we envisage that the person/people assisting Barrie would help: meet & greet groups, explain the site, deal with queries, minor maintenance, litter picking, ground/site maintenance equipment/loan hire and generally be there at pre-arranged fixed times to 'man' the site.
